02 / SAMPLE ROUTE SCHEDULE

The six fixed route fields

Every production SKU must disclose these fields. Pending values are not production facts.

ROUTE FIELD	REQUIRED DISCLOSURE
Model bounds	Named family plus allowlisted versions in final schedule
Provider transparency	Supplier legal identity and resale authority required
Region / residency	Requested location plus provider evidence required
Retention / training	No default claimed; final supplier terms control
Failover / substitution	No silent substitution; material changes require approval
Readiness status	PLANNING - SUPPLIER PENDING

WORKLOAD ELIGIBILITY

Public / synthetic	Preferred for qualification; supplier route still required
Ordinary business data	Separate route and handling review
Trade secrets / source code	Separate security review required
PHI / government / financial core	Not eligible on a general route
Cross-border personal data	Transfer and residency review required

Material changes include supplier, model version bounds, processing region, retention/training terms, failover target, capacity commitment or price basis. A material change requires a new route-schedule version and customer approval.

A production invoice must identify the usage source, route/SKU, billing dispute contact, tax treatment, currency, due date and authorized remittance owner.

04 / SAMPLE BENCHMARK SUMMARY

Measure without overstating

Benchmark results are decision evidence, not capacity, uptime or future-quality guarantees.

METHOD FIELD	REQUIRED RECORD
Mode	SIMULATION or LIVE PROVIDER - never unlabeled
Workload bundle	Named task set and domain coverage
Prompt-set version	Immutable ID and retained source
Sample size / repetitions	Declared before execution
Model / parameters	Exact model ID, temperature, max output and tools
Route / region / time	Recorded for every live run
Performance	TTFT, end-to-end latency, throughput and error rate
Statistics	p50 / p95 / p99 plus confidence or run variation
Quality rubric	Task-specific scoring with reviewer or judge method
Acceptance thresholds	Agreed before the test; no retroactive threshold
Raw evidence	Request IDs and retained results where permitted

Synthetic health check: verifies that a declared interface shape responds. Workload evaluation: measures quality and performance on a frozen representative task set. These are separate tests.
